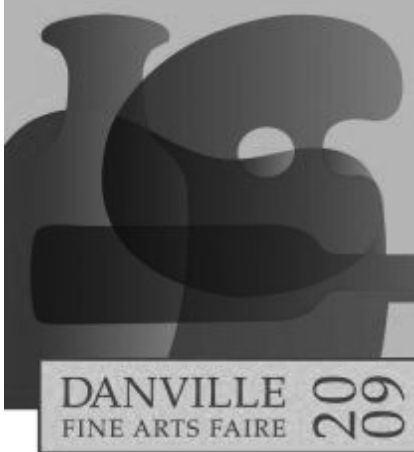




## Art comes to Danville

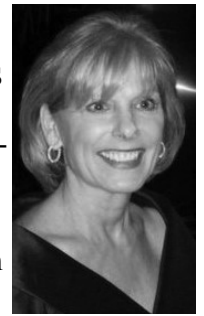

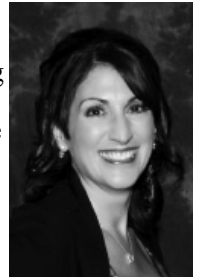
